Since 2019, Mr. de Andrade has served as Head of Research for Limagrain Field Seeds Asia Pacific, where he oversees the company's research strategy for key crops, including corn, rice, barley, and pearl millet, across critical markets in China, India, and Thailand. In this capacity, he leads the scientific development of advanced hybrids and varieties and serves on the boards of multiple joint ventures, effectively bridging research, business strategy, and commercial implementation.

Mr. de Andrade holds an INSEAD Leadership Certificate, an Executive MBA from the Dom Cabral Foundation, an MSc in Genetics and Plant Breeding, and a BSc in Agronomy, both from Viçosa University.
